



This stretch of four historic commercial storefronts on the corner of Bleeker and Christopher Streets in the West Village received a Landmarks Preservation approved historic renovation with interior reconfiguration.

One of the project goals was to expand the three commercial spaces fronting Bleeker Street in order to allow for a greater variety of commercial tenants to occupy those stores. The deep adjacent interior offered by the commercial space around the corner on Christopher Street was redistributed to the smaller spaces on Bleeker.

Together with a historic renovation of the facades and storefronts, the set of four commercial spaces now each offer tenants ample room for retail or food businesses.
